



ALEE SHELTER FOR ABUSED WOMEN

In Fiscal Year 2017 we served forty-nine (49) unduplicated adult clients and eleven (11) returning clients. Eight (8) clients are from the previous year.

These statistics rate Chamorro as the largest group served with Chuukese being the second largest group served.

Of the total number of women received at the women's shelter, there were two (2) women reporting physical abuse, eleven (11) women reporting emotional abuse, forty six (46) women reporting both physical and emotional abuse and one (1) woman reporting physical/sexual abuse.

We served a total of ninety-five (95) children this year; forty-eight (48) boys and forty-seven (47) girls. The ages of the children ranged from newborn to seventeen.

We continue to receive referrals from various sources including community agencies as well as former clients. Staff continues to participate in outreach events throughout the year in order to bring awareness. Alee Shelter has a good working relationship with other organizations in the community who are involved with providing assistance to victims such as the Guam Legal Services Corporation-Disability Law Center, the Guam Police Department Victim Advocates Unit, Superior Court of Guam Victim/Witness Assistance Services, Victim Advocates Reaching Out (VARO), the Department of Public Health and Social Services Bureaus of Economic Security and Nutrition Services, Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, the Guam Housing Corporation, the Salvation Army, and the University of Guam Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities Education, Research and Services and the Department of Labor.

The Alee Family Violence Shelter operates under funding from The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) Bureau of Social Services Administration (BOSSA), STOP Violence Against Women Act Grant through the Governor's Community Outreach Federal Programs Office and monetary or in-kind donations from the community.
