Artwork Requirements:

- Must be an original art design depicting a Super Hero
- Only one entry per student
- Must not have student's name on the front side of the artwork
- Should include a slogan/prevention message promoting safer sexual behaviors/choices
- Slogan must be incorporated into the artwork
- Should use no more than 4 colors
- Must be on white paper or poster, 8.5" x 11" in size
- Can be created with colored markers, acrylic paint, colored pencils, or graphic designs may use computer-generated applications
- Copyrighted characters, products, logos and trademarked or brand names cannot be used
- Must be able to reproduce for promotional usage by the Department of Public Health & Social Services

Entry Deadline:

- Entries should be submitted to the STD/HIV Program on or before Friday, April 14, 2017 at 12:00 pm
- Submit your artwork to your health teachers or the Department of Public Health and Social Services in Mangilao (Room 156 or 127) or the Northern Region Community Health Center in Dededo (Room 156)
- The Guidelines and Registration Form must be completed legibly and submitted with your artwork
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be announced on Friday, April 28, 2017
- The 1st place winner of the "STD/HIV Graphic Art Contest" will be featured in the Prutehi Hao "Protect Yourself" Campaign
