Ref: RFP/DPHSS-2017-006 (ADC) Request for Clarification

The following responses are provided in response to your request received on Tuesday, August 8, 2017:

Question #1:

#5, o – Registration of Clients: Specification to require notification of elder household to restrain in-door pets. Please clarify if ADC program staff will be required to conduct home visits.

Response #1:

#5 page 22 states Registration of Clients. Offeror's are required to demonstrate and implement written registration procedures that addresses, at a minimum, the following which include item "o" - Offers are required to address and inform clients that all pets at their homes shall be controlled...in accordance with Public Law 22-13 and 26-76.

Question #2:

#11 – Office/Facility: Specification listed three centers in the north, central and south, with corresponding villages identified to access centers in those respective localities. The northern villages of Yigo, Dededo, Tamuning, Tumon, and Harmon are not identified or indicated as to the center locality they will be assigned to.

Response #2:

For Yigo, Dededo, Tamuning, Tumon, and Harmon, clients from these areas should be part of the Adult Day Care (ADC) – Central, unless determined by Case Management Services program that the clients require ADC-Dementia Care Center/ADC-North.

Question #3:


#15, d – Provision of Services: Specification requires that all elders diagnosed with dementia "will receive ADC Center Program services at the Dementia Care Center/ADC-North, as practicable." This contradicts #11 in terms of elders from identified villages accessing the day care center for their locality, and based on existing day care participants, will mean the transfer of elders with dementia to one site only. This specification also does not consider #5, k – Registration of Clients – that the registration process is "to include information on registration

being transferable between the three (3) Adult Day Care (ADC) Centers on island, as applicable. Please clarify and identify what would be allowable “as applicable.”

Response #3:

#15, d (page 29 of 134) is amended from: *“Offerors are required to ensure all clients diagnosed and certified by a physician to have dementia will receive Adult Day Care (ADC) Center Program services at the Dementia Care Center/ADC-North, as practicable.”*

To now read: *“Offerors are required to ensure all clients diagnosed and certified by a physician to have dementia will receive Adult Day Care (ADC) Center Program services at the Dementia Care Center/ADC-North or ADC-South, as practicable.”*
