

GUAM DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

(Pertaining to Public Law 33-220 "Joaquin (KC) Concepcion, II Compassionate Cannabis Use Act of 2013)

Requirements needed for the Department of Agriculture's clearance for Medical Cannabis License

- 1.) Grower must provide a copy of ownership or lease agreement to property as part of registering farming activity with Agriculture.
- 2.) A property map (including aerial map) indicating boundary points.
- 3.) Grower must provide a production schedule (crop cycle), list of propagation materials i.e. fertilizers and pesticide types (application rates).
- 4.) Grower must maintain farm records (i.e. inventory, distribution, plant material disposal record indicating amounts per weight (grams/ounces) and disposal procedure in the event of crop failure.
- 5.) All for periodical visits for monitoring purposes both production and distribution of cannabis plant material(s).
- 6.) Bona-fide Farmer Certificate valid for a period of one year.
