A SURVEY OF RESOURCES FOR DIABETES CONTROL AND PREVENTION ON GUAM

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services Diabetes Prevention and Control Program

This report summarizes findings from a survey of diabetes service providers regarding the availability and adequacy of a spectrum of diabetes services on Guam.

INTRODUCTION

Diabetes presents a major public health challenge on Guam. Over the past decades, diabetes has risen in prevalence and currently is the fourth highest cause of mortality on the islandⁱ. Moreover, diabetes contributes to elevate the risk for heart disease, which is the leading cause of mortality. The health burden from what is often a chronic and disabling condition is compounded by the economic costs of treatment and care of diabetes itself as well as its complications, including heart disease, vascular disease, renal failure and blindness.

The Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) is the designated lead agency responsible for addressing the problem of diabetes. In recent years, the DPHSS Diabetes Prevention and Control Program initiated partnerships with other stakeholders in the community to build the island's capacity to prevent and control this major cause of mortality and morbidity. To date, accomplishments include the formation of a community Diabetes Control Coalition and the initiation of the development of a comprehensive strategic plan for diabetes control on Guam.

As part of the initial needs assessment, the coalition recognized the importance of mapping out existing diabetes prevention and control resources within the island. This inventory represents a systematic effort to collect and collate information on available services and expertise relevant to diabetes prevention and control. It is anticipated that this inventory will serve as a valuable resource for diabetes prevention/control program planners, service providers and for diabetes patients and their families.

Because the availability of health services and resources is often dynamic, this inventory should be viewed as a "living document" that may change over time. To facilitate the incorporation of new information and the deletion of obsolete data, the publication is intentionally created in hard copy as a binder. An electronic database

accompanying the publication should be updated to reflect the changes in the distribution and availability of community resources to combat diabetes.

Diabetes is the fourth leading cause of death on Guam.

The contents of this inventory reflect the best efforts of Health Partners, L.L.C. to assimilate and organize information provided by the various agencies, institutions, establishments and individual service providers who responded to an island-wide survey. The survey was voluntary; hence only those entities that participated are represented in the publication.

METHODOLOGY

After discussions with the DPHSS Diabetes Prevention and Control Program staff, Health Partners, L.L.C. developed a survey instrument to capture the data required for the diabetes prevention and control asset inventory. The draft survey instrument was peer-reviewed by members of the Guam Diabetes Control Coalition, and the instrument was revised to reflect the feedback from the coalition members. A copy of the final survey instrument is included in the Appendix.

A systematic search for potential providers of diabetes prevention and control services was done using the Yellow Pages of the both phone books used on Guam, as well as relevant directories of health professionals such as that published by the Guam Medical Society and the Guam Medical Association. DPHSS program staff and staff from organizations working in the area of diabetes control were queried regarding possible survey participants. All suggested participants were followed up.

Survey forms were distributed by fax, e-mail or in person. Follow-up phone calls and visits were conducted to maximize the response rate. All survey participants were informed at the outset of the nature and purpose of the survey. Responses were all voluntary.

An electronic database was developed using Microsoft Excel to record entries in submitted survey forms. Quantitative data were analyzed using summary statistics and percentages. Qualitative data were recorded, and re-classification or thematic analysis done when needed. The data collected were used to create information sheets that were collated into binders.

All information provided by the survey respondents was assumed to be valid. A separate, objective attempt to validate the data was not conducted. If responses were unclear, phone calls were made to the individual completing the survey form for clarification.

RESULTS

Respondent Demographics

Sixty (60) service providers were identified and sent survey forms. Of these, forty-six (46) returned completed forms, for a response rate of 76.7%




Figure 1. Nature of respondents' organizations/entities

The respondents represented a cross-section of private and public sector service providers, with over half (56%) comprised of private sector commercial or for-profit entities (Figure 1). These were primarily made up of private clinical practices with group or solo health practitioners. Close to one-third (29%) of respondents were local government agencies, usually representing the mayors' offices in various villages. About one-tenth (11%) were private sector not-for-profit agencies or nongovernmental organizations (NGOs). Faith-based groups and federal government agencies made up 2% each of the respondent total.




Figure 2. Nature of primary service provided

The primary nature of services offered roughly corresponded with the nature of the organization, with majority of the respondents offering clinical services (61%) followed by public service (20%). Financing and advocacy made up 7% and 6%, respectively of the total, while education, research and ancillary health care each accounted for 2% of all respondents (Figure 2).

Populations served

Table 1 and Figure 3 depict the general categories of populations served by the respondents. Table 2 and Figure 4 show the special populations served by the same respondents, while Table 3 and Figure 5 represent the various ethnic categories served.

Over 70% of respondents serve the general population categories and most ethnic sub-groups, but special populations, especially the homeless and people living with HIV and AIDs, and Other Asians are served by less than 70% of service providers surveyed.

Figure 4. Number of respondents serving special populations




Figure 5. Number of respondents serving ethnic sub-groups




The providers surveyed reported serving the homeless, people living with HIV/AIDs and Other Asians less frequently than other population sub-groups.

Services provided

Figure 6 shows the numbers and percentages of respondents providing specific types of services for diabetes prevention and control. Screening and diagnostic services are the most frequently provided (59%) followed closely by ancillary/support services (54%) and preventive services (52%). Treatment services are provided by a little over one-third (39%) of providers surveyed. Research is the least commonly provided service, with only 6% of providers reporting that they perform some form of research on diabetes.

Educational Services





Figure 7. Number of service providers offering educational services on diabetes

Eighteen of the 46 service providers (39%) reported providing education on diabetes to various groups. Of these, 14 (78%) offered general education on diabetes while 10 (56%) provided education on specific aspects of diabetes care, including, but not limited to, injecting insulin, nutrition for diabetes and diabetic foot care (Figure 7).

Education services are provided to a variety of audiences (Figure 8).

Preventive Services




Figure 9. Preventive services offered by service providers

Over half (52%), or 24 out of 46, service providers reported providing diabetes-related preventive services. The most commonly offered preventive service was brief advice for tobacco cessation (79%), followed by counseling on nutrition and exercise to prevent clinical diabetes (54%). Less than half (46% or 11 of 24) of the providers who offered preventive services reported providing immunization for pneumococcal pneumonia and other vaccine-preventable diseases, and only 12% (3 of 24) reported providing specific nutritional services, such as dietary planning (Figure 9).

Screening and Diagnostic Services




Figure 10. Screening and/or diagnostic services offered




Figure 11. Clinical diagnostics services offered

Of the 46 respondents, 27 (59%) reported offering diabetes-related screening and/or diagnostic services. The specific laboratory services offered are depicted in Figure 10. The specific clinical services are shown in Figure 11.

Treatment Services

Eighteen of the 46 providers (39%) offer treatment services for diabetes and diabetes related complications. Thirteen of the 18 (72%) provide outpatient medical treatment for diabetes, while 5 (28%) providers also offer inpatient medical treatment. Seven providers (39%) offer a variety of treatment services for diabetes-related complications (Table 4).





Ancillary Services

Fifty-two percent (52%), or 24 out of 46, providers reported offering ancillary services to persons with diabetes. The types of ancillary services offered are depicted in Figure 12. In relation to which local consultants the service providers refer to for the diagnosis and management of complex cases and diabetes complications, Dr. Joel Rubio (currently the only endocrinologist on Guam) was mentioned most often. In relation to which local consultants the service providers refer to for counseling and nutrition support, the Seventh Day Adventist clinic was mentioned most frequently. The Department of Public Health and Social Services was indicated by one service provider as their referral point.





The service providers who refer to off-island medical centers indicated that they send patients to St. Luke's Medical Center in the Philippines and Good Samaritan Hospital in California.

Financial Services

Six of the 46 providers surveyed reported providing some form of financial assistance or service to diabetes patients. Of these, two provided grants or donations, with no repayment needed. Two of the respondents were private health insurance agencies and one respondent was the Bureau of Health Financing which provides financial assistance to needy families; all three provide insurance coverage for diabetes care.

Clinical Practice Characteristics

Service providers who offer clinical services for diabetes patients were asked additional questions regarding their practice characteristics. Nineteen providers responded to these questions.

Table 5 shows the number of providers reporting the presence of specially trained diabetes health professionals. The numbers reflect a scarcity in human resources for diabetes prevention and control on Guam.




Figure 13. Percentage of clinical practice with a diagnosis of diabetes

Figure 13 depicts the percentage of the clinical practice's clientele carrying a diagnosis of diabetes. Almost half of the clinical practices (47%) reported that 0-25% of their patients are diabetics. Two practices (10%) reported that 76-100% of their patients are diabetics.




Figure 14. Payment plans accepted by diabetes clinical providers

Figure 14 shows the types of payment plans accepted by the 19 clinical providers. The data indicates that local private insurance plans and self-pay are the payment plans most commonly accepted by these providers. Most providers (84%) also accept social insurance.

Diabetes Data




Figure 15. Types of diabetes data collected




Figure 16. Uses for diabetes data

The survey respondents were also asked if they collected data on diabetes. Ten of the 46 (22%) reported collecting and storing data on diabetes. Figure 15 shows the types of data collected and Figure 16 depicts the uses for the data. "Other" uses of data included advocacy (1 provider), community information (2 providers) and provision of data at the request of clients/patients (1 provider).

All 10 providers who collect diabetes data store this in an electronic database. Three providers also maintain hard copies of their data. Eight of the 10 providers indicated a willingness to share some of their data, although none were willing to share their entire database. Five of the 8 would share a summary of their data, 4 providers would share portions of their data summary and 2 would share selected portions of their database. The barriers to data sharing were clinical confidentiality/HIPAA compliance (4 providers), research confidentiality (2 providers), data as proprietary information/owned by company (1 provider) and agency/company policy (1 provider).

Diabetes Research

Only 3 (7%) of the 46 providers surveyed reported doing research on diabetes. The research is health-related, with 2 providers doing research on diabetes kidney disease and 1 provider doing research on the genetics of diabetes. One provider is funded through a federal grant; the other 2 providers did not provide information on their funding source.

DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSIONS

This was a voluntary survey of known providers of diverse diabetes-related services on Guam. A concerted effort to obtain responses from all known diabetes service providers was made, but a number of providers opted not to participate in the survey. The response rate to the survey was 76.7%. The respondents represented a variety of organizations and entities involved in diabetes prevention and/or control. Over half came from the private sector, primarily clinical practices.

The populations served by these practices encompassed the different categories of the general population. However, the homeless, persons living with HIV/AIDs and Other Asians were less likely to be reported as a sub-group served by the providers. If diabetes prevalence was uniformly distributed across all population sub-groups, it would indicate that these three sub-groups are relatively underserved, either because they do not avail of diabetes prevention and control services as much as the rest of the population or there are barriers to their accessing available services. Regardless of the reason, this finding may justify the need for greater outreach services to these particular population sub-groups. Also, there may be a need to further explore what barriers to diabetes service exist, if any, for these groups.

Only 4 providers in this survey reported providing financial services for diabetes care. One provider was the Bureau of Health Financing, which offers financial assistance to needy families. The other 3 were local private health insurance agencies, which require patients to purchase insurance. While the impoverished and those who can afford private insurance are covered by these financial providers, families who do not make the poverty cut-offs but are not economically well-off enough to afford private insurance are excluded from financial coverage. This represents a potentially vulnerable population subgroup that may be barred from accessing services because of financial hardship.

The providers offer assorted services that cover the spectrum of diabetes prevention and care. However, while all critical service areas are addressed, the number of providers offering each service may not be sufficient to meet the demand, given the high prevalence of diabetes on Guam. The data indicate that while preventive, screening, diagnostic and ancillary health services are available from over half of the providers responding to this survey, educational and treatment services are less likely to be offered.

Furthermore, when assessing the preventive and treatment services available, certain gaps emerge. For instance, brief cessation advice is offered by most providers but not nutritional counseling, immunization and intensive cessation counseling. On the

treatment side, routine treatment in the outpatient setting is much more available than inpatient treatment and specialized treatment for complex cases or for diabetes-related complications. In part, this may be directly related to the paucity of health professionals with specialized training in diabetes care.

These findings are consistent with the findings reported in the corresponding diabetes patient surveyⁱⁱ, which found that diabetes patients on Guam are more likely to be satisfied with preventive, lifestyle management and routine clinical services and less likely to be content with specialized care for diabetes complications and support services such as mental health counseling. However, patients are also most likely to identify education, prevention and lifestyle management as service gaps on the island. Other service gaps that were identified by diabetes patients as priorities for Guam include improved access to specialists and specialized care, specifically for diabetes complications, and financial assistance for diabetes care and medications.

In addition to the relative insufficiency in the number of providers, the quality of services provided also needs to be assessed. This survey was not designed to address this issue. Nonetheless, it is a vital one that should be looked at in the future. Indications from the corresponding patient survey point to a failure on Guam of service providers to fully comply with established clinical practice recommendations for the prevention and control of diabetes.ⁱⁱⁱ

This survey is the initial step in assessing Guam's existing resources and current needs in relation to diabetes prevention and control. The feedback from these respondents should provide guidance as the DPHSS and its partners develop a strategic plan to better address the issue of diabetes on Guam.
