## Contigo Kids Cleanable Water Bottles Voluntary Recall

The Department of Public Health and Social Services would like to inform the public of a voluntary recall for Contigo Kids Cleanable water bottles because of reports of the water bottle's spout detaching, which poses a choking hazard to children. Contigo has received a total of 427 reports of the spout detaching, including 27 spouts found in children's mouth.

This voluntary recall involves Contigo Kids Cleanable water bottles and replacement lids that were given to consumers as part of the August 2019 recall of this product. The base and cover of the clear silicone spout will always be BLACK. Only black colored spout base and spout cover models are included in this recall. Contigo is printed on the rim and along the front near the bottom of the bottle. The water bottles come in three sizes (13-ounce, 14-ounce and 20-ounce) and four colors (solid color, graphics, stainless steel, and stainless-steel solid colors). The water bottles were sold individually as well as in two-packs and three-packs.

The Department has not received any local report of injuries or illnesses associated with the use of the recalled commodities.
