Our office like most/all other Dental offices follows the infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We follow the activities of these agencies so that we are up-to-date on any new rulings or guidance that may be issued.

Patients will see some changes when it is time for their next appointment. We made these changes to help protect our patients and staff. For example:

- Our office will communicate with patients beforehand to ask some screening questions. They'll be asked those same questions again when you are in the office.
- We have hand sanitizer that we will ask patients to use when they enter the office. They will also find some in the reception area and other places in the office for them to use as needed.
- Patients will see that our waiting room will no longer offer magazines, children's toys, and so forth since those items are difficult to clean and disinfect.
- Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. That might mean that they're offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment.
- · We will do our best to allow greater time between patients to reduce waiting times for them, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the reception area at any one time.
