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## National Influenza Vaccination Week, January 10-16, 2010

Today's message focuses on Young Adults (19 through 24 year olds)

The Department of Public Health and Social Services joins the nation in celebrating National Influenza Vaccination Week (NIVW). NIVW is a national observance that was established to highlight the importance of continuing influenza vaccination, as well as fostering greater use of flu vaccine after the holiday season. This year's NIVW is January 10-16, 2010.

In line with NIVW, DPHSS continues to encourage island residents to get vaccinated. DPHSS will be holding an H1N1 Mass Vaccination Point of Dispensing (POD) for island residents on Saturday, January 16 at the Yigo Gym between 9 am to 12 noon. The last person to be vaccinated will be accepted at 11:30 am.

Today's message focuses on **Young Adults** (19 through 24 year olds) and highlights the importance of flu vaccination for people 19 through 24 years of age.
