2020 Call for Centenarians – Extended Deadline

As part of this year's Annual Senior Citizens Month celebration, a Centenarian Recognition is being planned to honor our Centenarians in May 2020. A *Centenarian* is any senior citizen who is or will be 100 years of age or older between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020. In addition, for the purpose of this program in regards to eligibility, the Centenarian's primary residence must be in Guam.

To assist the Department of Public Health and Social Services, Division of Senior Citizens in recognizing Guam's Centenarians, the public is encouraged to inform a Centenarian or the Centenarian's family or caregiver about this hallmark event and the needed information such as where to access and submit biological forms for Centenarians to be honored at this year's event.
