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DPHSS Guidance Memo. 2020-11

RE: Additional Guidance Relative to Executive Order Nos. 2020-04, 2020-11, 2020-14

The purpose of this Guidance is to provide further clarification on the voluntary quarantine requirements for all persons arriving in Guam.

The following clarification is provided and is applicable to Executive Order 2020-04, 2020-11, 2020-14 any other Executive Orders regarding entry into Guam and the March 31, 2020 Public Health Directive relative to quarantine of all persons arriving in Guam.

As part of Guam's effort to contain the introduction and spread of COVID-19 all persons entering Guam by air or sea shall be subject to voluntary quarantine at a GovGuam quarantine facility, or at designated and approved quarantine location for a period of 14-days.

All persons must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement and any persons who refuse to sign will be subject to Involuntary Quarantine.

Current residents of Guam, or persons who are essential healthcare or other essential workers, or persons at the Guam port of entry (POE) who traveled to Guam because of an emergency or personal hardship situation as determined and approved by Guam Department of Health and Social Services (DPHSS), may be allowed to complete the 14-day quarantine requirement at their home residence or rented lodging location.

All non-residents are subject to 14-day quarantine at a GovGuam designated quarantine facility. Any and all costs associated with the quarantine and/or treatment of individuals who are subject to restricted entry into Guam pursuant Executive Orders 2020-04, 2020-11, and 2020-14, shall be the responsibility of the individual and the carrier that the individual contracted with to travel to Guam.

According to the Guam International Airport Authority, currently all transiting passengers must go to the GovGuam quarantine facility for the transiting time period and will be transported back to the airport for departing flight from Guam.

Compliance with voluntary quarantine regardless of location is subject to monitoring, verification, and enforcement. The knowing and intentional failure to follow any part of this order constitutes a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than one year or both (10 GCA, Chapter 19, §19604 (c) Cooperation).

- 1. <u>Current Guam</u> residents entering by air or sea are subject to voluntary quarantine at a designated and approved quarantine location for a period of 14-days.
 - a. Guam residents that are allowed to complete the 14-day quarantine requirement at their home residence, or rented lodging location must adhere to the following:
 - i. Must provide any one of the following as evidence of current residency status:
 - a valid Guam ID
 - a Mayor's verification
 - a local physical address and contact information and sign an affidavit attesting to its validity.
 - ii. Must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - iii. Must provide:
 - Quarantine location address
 - A working phone number where they may be reached.
 - iv. Current resident may choose the option to stay at the Government of Guam quarantine facility at the government's expense.
 - v. Must remain in quarantine for 14 days from the date of arrival in Guam.
 - vi. Must not have any visitors at the quarantine location.
 - vii. Must not leave the quarantine location to: shop for groceries, conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g., massage, haircut, manicure/pedicure), go to the beach, work or any public places.
 - viii. May leave the quarantine location for medical emergencies, or to seek medical care.
 - ix. Must adhere to symptom monitoring put forth by the Guam DPHSS.
 - x. May leave their quarantine location to transit out of Guam even if it is prior to the completion of the 14-day quarantine period.

2. <u>Non-Residents</u> entering Guam by air or sea are subject to voluntary quarantine at the GovGuam designated quarantine facility or other designated location.

- a. Non-Residents entering Guam will complete the 14-day quarantine requirement at the GovGuam quarantine facility and must adhere to the following:
 - i. Must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - ii. Must complete 14-day quarantine.
 - iii. Must be transported directly from the airport to the GovGuam designated quarantine facility.
 - iv. Must agree to remain in the GovGuam designated quarantine facility in an assigned room and agree to not have any visitors, or visit any other rooms in the facility.
 - v. Must agree to be monitored daily for symptoms of COVID-19. Symptoms include, but are not limited to:
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills
 - Headaches
 - Loss of smell or taste

- vi. Must remain at the quarantine facility and only leave for medical emergencies and approved medical appointments.
- vii. May leave the GovGuam designated quarantine facility after presentation of valid and verifiable information showing evidence of intent to leave Guam even before the end of the 14-day quarantine period; and will be transported directly from the quarantine facility to the airport or other point of departure.
- b. If a non-resident presents a valid diagnostic laboratory COVID-19 PCR test result, the individual can complete the 14 day quarantine requirement at their rental lodging and must adhere to Section 2a.
- 3. <u>Crew members</u> for any conveyance, arriving by air or sea, are considered essential workers for the functioning of Guam; however, in order to maintain the protection of public health, the following requirements apply:
 - a. Crew members must adhere to the following requirements:
 - i. They must quarantine for 14 days at their personal residence or rental lodging location.
 - ii. They must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - iii. Each crew member must provide:
 - Quarantine location address
 - A working phone number, where they may be reached
 - iv. They must remain in quarantine for 14 days from the date of arrival in Guam.
 - v. They must adhere to symptom monitoring by the DPHSS.
 - vi. They must not have any visitors at their quarantine location.
 - vii. They may leave the quarantine location for medical emergencies or to seek medical care.
 - viii. They may leave to get take-out food; however, they may not leave quarantine to shop for groceries, conduct banking transactions, seek personal hygiene services (e.g. haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure), go to the beach or visit any public places.
 - ix. They may leave the quarantine location to transit out of Guam even if it is prior to the completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - b. Dependents and traveling companions of crew members are required to quarantine within the GovGuam quarantine facility.
 - i. Crew members may elect to quarantine within the GovGuam quarantine facility alongside dependents and traveling companions.
 - ii. Dependents and traveling companions of crew can transit out of Guam even if it is prior to completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - iii. Dependents and traveling companions of crew are subject to government of Guam regulations.
 - c. Dependents defined as minors traveling with crew member may be quarantined at their personal residence or rental lodging location alongside the crew member. Dependents must also adhere to all of the requirements of quarantine.

- 4. <u>Essential Healthcare Professionals</u> are considered essential workers during COVID-19 emergency response for the functioning of Guam; however, in order to maintain the protection of public health, the following requirements apply:
 - a. Essential Healthcare Professionals must adhere to the following requirements:
 - i. They must possess a letter from the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) at the Guam port of entry, indicating that they are an essential healthcare professional/provider serving to maintain the integrity of Guam's healthcare system.
 - ii. They must quarantine for 14 days at their personal residence, or rental lodging location.
 - iii. They must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - iv. Essential Healthcare Professional must provide:
 - Quarantine location address
 - A working phone number, where they may be reached
 - Name of the healthcare facility, or location where they will be working
 - v. When not at work or to get take-out food, they must remain quarantine at their personal residence, or rental lodging location for 14 days from the date of arrival in Guam.
 - vi. They may not leave the quarantine location to: shop for groceries, conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (massage, haircut, manicure/pedicure), go to the beach or any public places.
 - vii. They may leave the quarantine location for medical emergencies or to seek medical care.
 - viii. They must not have any visitors at their quarantine location.
 - ix. They must adhere to symptom monitoring before each shift and during each shift at least 4 hours after starting their shift by their healthcare organization's infection control staff.
 - x. They must report any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and immediately stop working and isolate if they become symptomatic.
 - xi. They may leave the quarantine location to transit out of Guam even if it is prior to the completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - b. Traveling companions of Essential Healthcare Professionals are required to quarantine at the GovGuam quarantine facility.
 - i. The essential healthcare worker may elect to quarantine in the GovGuam quarantine facility alongside their traveling companions until completion of the 14-day quarantine period. If electing to do so, the essential healthcare worker will not be allowed to leave for work.
 - c. Dependents defined as minors or persons whose sole caretaker is the essential healthcare worker may be quarantined at their personal residence or rental lodging location alongside the essential healthcare worker. Dependents must also adhere to all of the requirements of quarantine.

- 5. <u>Essential Workers from other industries</u> (DOD and civilian construction, federal government, scientific, law enforcement, research, industrial technical professionals, bank couriers, etc.) may be considered essential for the functioning of Guam; however, in order to maintain the protection of public health, the following requirements apply:
 - a. These essential workers must adhere to the following requirements:
 - i. They must possess a DPHSS letter from the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) at the Guam port of entry indicating that they are coming to Guam to provide an essential service.
 - ii. They must quarantine for 14 days at their personal residence, or rental lodging location.
 - iii. They must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - iv. Each essential worker must provide:
 - Ouarantine location address
 - A working phone number, where they may be reached
 - Location where they will be working
 - v. They must remain in the designated quarantine location leaving only to go to and from work each day under a Restriction of Movement (ROM) until the completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - vi. When not at work or to get take-out food, they may not leave quarantine to shop for groceries, conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g. haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure), go to the beach, or visit any public places.
 - vii. They may leave the quarantine location for medical emergencies or to seek medical care.
 - viii. They may not have any visitors at their quarantine location.
 - ix. They must adhere to symptom monitoring by the DPHSS.
 - x. They must report any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and immediately stop working and be isolated if they become symptomatic.
 - xi. They may leave the quarantine location to transit out of Guam even if it is prior to the completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - b. Dependents and traveling companions of essential workers are required to quarantine within the GovGuam quarantine facility.
 - i. Essential workers may elect to quarantine within the GovGuam facility alongside dependents and traveling companions. If electing to do so, they will not be allowed to leave for work.
 - ii. Dependents and traveling companions of essential workers can transit out of Guam even if it is prior to completion of the 14-day quarantine period.
 - iii. Dependents and traveling companions of essential workers are subject to government of Guam regulations regarding costs associated with quarantine.
 - c. Dependents defined as minors or persons whose sole caretaker is the essential worker may be quarantined at their personal residence or rental lodging location alongside the essential worker. Dependents must also adhere to all of the requirements of quarantine.

6. Any person arriving in Guam in response to a family emergency, has a serious acute or chronic medical condition, a behavior health condition, has had a recent medical procedure or surgery, has requested consideration of an emergency or hardship circumstance or provides information about any other issue that may make it unsuitable for them to be in 14-day voluntary quarantine at the GovGuam facility, must first go directly from the airport to the GovGuam quarantine facility.

Once at the GovGuam quarantine facility, consideration and decisions about the suitability for the transfer of these persons to 14-day quarantine at their residence, or rental lodging location will be reviewed and determined by GovGuam and DPHSS staff. The decision will be based on specific criteria and evidence, including but not limited to: the death of a family member; visiting a family member under hospice, or at the hospital; or providing care for a sick family member.

- a. These persons must adhere to the following:
 - i. Must sign a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement.
 - ii. Must complete 14-day quarantine.
 - iii. Must be transported directly from the airport to the GovGuam designated quarantine facility.
 - iv. Must agree to remain in the GovGuam designated quarantine facility in an assigned room and agree to not have any visitors or visit any other rooms in the facility.
 - v. Must agree to be monitored daily for symptoms of COVID-19. Symptoms include, but are not limited to:
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills
 - Headaches
 - Loss of smell or taste
 - vi. Must remain at the quarantine facility and only leave for medical emergencies and approved medical appointments.
 - vii. May leave the GovGuam designated quarantine facility after presentation of valid and verifiable information showing evidence of intent to leave Guam even before the end of the 14-day quarantine period; and will be transported directly from the quarantine facility to the airport, or other point of departure.

- 7. Active duty military and dependents, DOD civilians and dependents, and DOD contractors arriving by commercial air or sea are subject to the aforementioned guidelines, with the following modifications:
 - 1) Current and future residents of Guam will abide by the Current Guam Resident guidelines, showing DOD ID and proof of residence in the form of:
 - a. Utility bill showing local address,
 - b. Permanent Change of Station orders, or
 - c. Self-attestation on Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement form including name and contact information of command.
 - 2) Transiting air and sea crew members will abide by the Crew Members guidelines, showing DOD ID <u>and</u> proof of status in the form of:
 - a. Transit status for the dates of quarantine on military command letterhead, including name and contact information of command.
 - 3) Active duty and DOD civilians and contractors on temporary duty status will abide by the Essential Workers from Other Industries guidelines, showing DOD ID and proof of essential service in the form of:
 - a. Temporary Duty orders, or
 - b. Mission essential status for the dates of quarantine on military command letterhead, including contact information of command.
 - 4) For all voluntary quarantines in residences or rental lodging, all daily screening reports will be made to the appropriate sponsoring command representative in lieu of Guam DPHSS.

Voluntary Quarantine Order ARRIVING PERSONS- CURRENT GUAM RESIDENT

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. A determination has been made to allow you to quarantine at your place of residence or rental lodging location because you have provided valid evidence that you are a current Guam resident.

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency disease control measures to slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to proceed directly from the airport to the designated quarantine location which is either my residence or rental lodging.
- I agree to comply with voluntary quarantine order for 14-days from my date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to remain in my designated quarantine location leaving only for medical emergencies and to seek medical care
- I agree to get support from people, who are not in quarantine or isolation, who will drop off food/supplies, but I will not let them enter my designated quarantine location.
- I will not leave quarantine to shop for groceries, to conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g., haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure) or go to the beach or visit any public places.
- I agree to not allow any visitors.
- I agree to monitor myself for symptoms of COVID-19 and report everyday:

Voluntary Quarantine Order ARRIVING PASSENGER – NON-RESIDENT OF GUAM

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. Per Governor of Guam Executive Order, all arriving NON-RESIDENT passengers are subject to quarantine at a GovGuam designated quarantine facility.

Any and all costs associated with the quarantine and/or treatment of individuals who are subject to restricted entry into Guam pursuant to the Executive Orders shall be the responsibility of the individual and the carrier that the individual contracted with to travel to Guam

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency public health measures to help slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a *Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement*, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to comply with the voluntary quarantine order for 14-days from my date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to be transported directly from the airport to the GovGuam designated quarantine facility.
- I agree to remain in the GovGuam designated quarantine facility in my assigned room and I agree to not have any visitors or visit any other rooms in the facility.
- I agree to be monitored for symptoms of COVID-19 including but not limited to:
 - o Fever (Feel feverish or exact temperature if known >100.4°F/38°C)
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - o Chills
 - Headaches
 - Loss of smell or taste
- I understand that I will be provided (3) meals a day.
- I understand that I can only leave the quarantine facility for medical emergencies and approved medical appointments.
- I understand that I may leave the quarantine facility before the end of the 14 day quarantine period if I provide verifiable information that I am leaving Guam even before the end of the 14 day quarantine period. In these instances, I will be transported directly from the quarantine facility to the airport or other point of departure.

THE KNOWING AND INTENTIONAL FAILURE TO FOLLOW ANY PART OF THIS ORDER CONSTITUTES A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN ONE YEAR OR BOTH (10 GCA, Chapter 19, §19604 (c) Cooperation).

QUARANTINE FACILITY FAQ

1. If I, a non-resident, get a negative COVID-19 test, can I go to my rental lodging?

Yes. If a non-resident presents a valid diagnostic laboratory **COVID-19 PCR negative test** result for SARS Cov2 within 72 hours of arrival in Guam, the individual can complete the 14-day quarantine requirement at their rental lodging.

2. Will I be tested while in quarantine?

People will only be tested during quarantine if they develop symptoms of COVID-19.

3. If I have an extenuating family circumstance, can I go home?

Extenuating circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please provide documentation to onsite Public Health staff so that they may assess these situations. Once documentation is received, it may take time for Public Health to respond to your inquiry.

4. If I have medical conditions, does this mean I can go home?

Persons with medical conditions are not exempt from quarantine. Some people with medical conditions may quarantine at home. Facility medical staff determine the need to quarantine at home. Public Health will assess the home situation before granting approval to home quarantine. These individuals must still undergo monitoring by Public Health staff.

5. Can I end my quarantine early?

No. The quarantine period is based on the best available scientific evidence for COVID-19 at this time. There is no substitute for this incubation period.

6. If I begin experiencing symptoms while in quarantine, what do I do?

If you begin to experience even mild symptoms or simply feel different that you normally do, please bring this up to the staff conducting your daily screenings. If you urgently need medical attention, alert the front desk to call 911.

7. Can I visit my doctor while in quarantine?

You may attend pre-arranged medical appointments if we are able to verify that the clinic will accept you while quarantined. You must alert the medical and front desk staff about the appointment 24 hours before your appointment. We will arrange for transport from the facility to your appointment and back to the facility afterwards.

8. If I have a mental health concern, who do I contact?

Public Health Social Workers are onsite to connect you to a provider. The 24-hour Crisis Hotline is available if you would like to speak with someone urgently. The number is 647-8833.

ARRIVING CREW MEMBER - ESSENTIAL WORKFORCE

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. Because you are a crew member you are designated as essential workforce for Guam and a determination has been made to allow you to quarantine at your personal residence, hotel or rental lodging.

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency public health measures to help slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to comply with the voluntary quarantine order for 14-days from the date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to proceed directly from the airport to the designated quarantine location which is either my residence, hotel or rental lodging location.
- I can get take-out food; however, I will not leave quarantine to shop for groceries, to conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g., haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure) or go to the beach or visit any public places.
- I agree to not allow any visitors at my designated quarantine location.
- I agree that dependents and traveling companions are required to quarantine within the GovGuam quarantine facility (dependent minors may be quarantined alongside crew member).
- I agree to monitor myself for symptoms of COVID-19 and report every day.

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. However, a determination has been made to allow you to quarantine at your place of residence, hotel or rental lodging location under a Restriction of Movement (ROM) because of your designation as essential healthcare professional for Guam.

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency public health measures to help slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to comply with the voluntary quarantine order for 14-days from my date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to proceed directly from the airport to the designated quarantine location which is my residence, hotel, or rental lodging location.
- I agree to remain in my designated quarantine location leaving only to go to and from work each day (ROM), for medical emergencies, or to seek medical care.
- I can get take-out food; however, I will not leave quarantine to get groceries, conduct banking, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g., haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure etc.) go to the beach, or visit any public places.

ARRIVING PERSON- ESSENTIAL WORKFORCE

RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM)

(e.g., DOD construction, federal government, scientific, law enforcement, security, research, technical industrial, bank couriers etc.)

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. However, a determination has been made to allow you to quarantine at your place of residence, hotel or rental lodging location under a Restriction of Movement (ROM) because of your designation as essential workforce for Guam.

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency public health measures to help slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to comply with the voluntary quarantine order for 14-days from my date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to proceed directly from the airport to the designated quarantine location which is my residence, hotel, or rental lodging location.
- I agree to remain in my designated quarantine location leaving only to go to and from work each day (ROM), for medical emergencies, or to seek medical care.

Voluntary Quarantine Order ARRIVING PERSON- EMERGENCY/HARDSHIP RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT (ROM)

Based on your recent travel history you are subject to 14-day quarantine from your date of arrival in Guam. However, a determination has been made to allow you to quarantine at your place of residence, hotel, or rental lodging location under a Restriction of Movement (ROM) because of your emergency or hardship circumstances prompting your travel to Guam.

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) has put in place emergency public health measures to help slow the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of the others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary quarantine order.

By signing a *Voluntary Quarantine Acknowledgement*, Guam DPHSS hereby orders you to comply with the following:

- I agree to proceed directly from the airport to the designated quarantine location.
- I agree to comply with the voluntary quarantine order for 14 days from my date of arrival in Guam.
- I agree to remain in the designated quarantine location under a Restriction of Movement (ROM) which allows me to leave quarantine only to participate in or support activities/events related to my emergency or hardship circumstance or for medical emergencies or to seek medical care. I agree to observe current social/physical distancing practices i.e., wearing facemask and avoiding large crowds.
- I agree that I will not leave quarantine to shop for groceries, conduct banking transactions, seek personal care or hygiene services (e.g., haircut, massage, manicure/pedicure) or the beach or any public places.
- I agree to not allow any visitors at my designated quarantine location.
