

VOLUNTARY MONITORING REQUIREMENT



ARRIVING PASSENGERS LOW RISK AREA STAYING <5 NIGHTS

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) implemented emergency public health measures to contain the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this monitoring requirement.

- No quarantine or testing is required, however, you must still comply with symptom monitoring and tracking for the duration of your stay. Report any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 to Guam DPHSS Mon-Sat / 8am-5pm at (671) 787-6327 or (671) 727-5236 and quarantine until instructions are provided.
- You must observe social distancing, wear face coverings and practice proper handwashing etiquette.
- You must contact Guam DPHSS (at the same number above) in the event that you decide to remain on Guam more than 5 nights as you will be required to take a COVID-19 test.
