



VOLUNTARY MONITORING REQUIREMENT



ARRIVING PASSENGERS LOW-RISK AREA STAYING >5 NIGHTS

Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) implemented emergency public health measures to contain the introduction and spread of COVID-19 in Guam. It is very important for the protection of your own health and that of others in Guam that you abide by all aspects of this voluntary monitoring requirement.

- You must provide an acceptable negative COVID-19 test administered within 5 days prior to arrival on Guam or submit for COVID-19 testing post-arrival Day 5. Please call the DPHSS Community Health Centers at (671) 635-7400 or (671) 635-4410 to schedule your test at least 2 days in advance.

Note: This document must be presented at the time of testing.

- You must observe social distancing, wear face coverings and practice proper hand-washing etiquette.
- You must comply with symptom monitoring and tracking for 14 days by reporting any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 to Guam DPHSS **Mon-Sat / 8am-5pm at (671) 685-4577 or (671) 727-5384** and quarantine until instructions are provided.
