FISHING TOURNAMENT

July 27, 2020

Shut up & Fish Guam hereby submits the following plan to comply with the Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) PCOR 3 Guidance. Shut up & Fish Guam plans to conduct a Fishing Tournament Saturday, August 29, 2020.

□ This tournament plan will be distributed electronically to all in the fishing community who may want to join.

□ Registration for the tournament will be done online eliminating the need for participants to sign up in person.

□ All participants fill out a registration form that provides contact information for every passenger on the boat, for safety and contact tracing purposes.

□ All boats must maintain a distance from each other on, off and between other boaters.

□ All staff of the tournament shall be required to practice social distancing and wear a mask at all times.

□ Tournament will be limited to a maximum of 4 persons per boat and only the captain or one designated person from each boat will be present at the weigh station.

□ The number of spectators will be limited and should be six feet apart and wear face masks.

□ The weigh station will have 2 designated persons to help minimize physical contact during weigh-ins.

D Appropriate signage will be posted on our website at registration stating the rules for the tournament and that all participants/crew must not have traveled within the past 14 days and no one within their household has been diagnosed with COVID19 or has COVID19 related symptoms.

□ Participants shall self-assess prior to joining the Tournament. If a participant has cold symptoms, such as cough/sneezing/fever, stay home.

□ The tournament will take place from 6am-6pm. Each boat will be out in the middle of the ocean with their own crew members. Everyone will be required to wear a mask upon returning to the dock as they get off their boats.

D Tournament will be set for one day only. There will be no banquet held to avoid contact. Winners will be announced at the end of the tournament and only the captain of the boat will be asked to be present to claim their prize via Virtual Facebook Live.

□ Participants will be limited to 25, to stay under the 50 persons threshold. We will control the amount of people in a single place at a time. Chairs and tables will be 6 ft apart if needed.
