

- c. Infant should be transported in their car seats.
- d. Same parent or designated person should drop-off and pick up the child everyday. No older people or grandparents should not pick-up children.

5. Child Screening method.

- a. Conduct a temperature screening
- b. Put on disposable gloves.
- c. Always sanitize the thermometer with wipes (alcohol based)

6. Clean and Disinfect

- a. Develop a schedule for cleaning and disinfecting the facility.
- b. Routinely clean and sanitize surfaces, objects and toys that are frequently touched.
- c. Use only EPA products according to the direction level.
- d. All cleaning materials should be kept secure and out of reach of children.
- e. Cleaning products should not be used near children and make sure there is adequate ventilation when using these products.
- f. Clean and disinfect beddings.

7. Isolation and Caring for Sick Children.

- a. Have an isolation area that can be used to isolate sick children.
- b. Close-off area that can be used to isolate sick child.
- c. Open outside doors and windows to increase air circulation.
- d. Clean and disinfect all areas used by a sick person.
