SAFE RETURN TO WORSHIP

PREPARATION

PLANNING

- Assign responsibility for monitoring and incorporating government orders and guidance.
- Assign responsibility for coordinating with local health authorities and law enforcement.
- Provide leaders, ministers and staff with mask and other protective equipment to wear while serving.
- Establish protocols for physical distancing before, during and after services including seating arrangements, modified worship practices and dismissal procedures.
- Continue offering online worship options for those who are sick, higher risk, have been exposed to a coronavirus (COVID-19) patient within the last 14 days or are otherwise uncomfortable gathering in person.
- Do not share equipment used for worship services such as microphones, etc.
- Minimize areas of building being used during services and gatherings to minimize disinfecting needs.
- Designate 1-in-1-out protocol.
- Establish frequency and processes for enhanced cleaning and disinfecting-between services at minimum.
- Develop admission criteria for worship services, noting that anyone who is ill or appears ill should plan to worship remotely.
- Postpone children's activities for additional safeguards.

BUILDING

- Conduct a thorough facility inspection/walk-through to check on the safety of the building.
- Address any slip, trip and fall hazards.
- Thoroughly clean and disinfect the building and contents.
- Ensure cleaning supplies are on hand.
- Make hand sanitizer and/or hand wipes available throughout the building.
- Post signs regarding social distancing, safety measures and handwashing.
- Impose hand washing.

SUPPLIES

- Disinfecting agents for the building
- Hand sanitizer for staff and attendees.
- Masks and gloves for staff.
- Face coverings and thermometer for temperature check.

Implementation

BEFORE SERVICES

- Disinfect the worship area.
- Disinfect worship materials such as microphones.
- Disinfect restroom and other common areas.
- Replenish disinfecting and covering supplies.

DURING SERVICES

- At entrance, prop door open, apply admission criteria, check temperature and provide hand sanitizer.
- Seat individuals or family units from front to back.
- Maintain physical distance (six ft.apart).
- Face covering such as face mask or face shield must be worn.
- Offering holders will use protective equipment such as mask and gloves.
- Communion will be served by staff with mask and gloves.
- Communion cups are disposable and will be disposed by every individual who used.

AFTER SERVICES

- Dismiss attendees from closest to furthest from the exit.
- No hand shaking or any physical contact. Wave or one hand crossed the chest as a sign of greetings.
- Disinfect worship area, materials, rooms used and frequently touched items such as doors, light switches, chairs, etc.
- Disinfect offerings.
- Maintain physical distance and wear face coverings to protect each other.
