Mitigation Plan for being in the Church Building

Church Access

1. Church attendance will be limited to only 25% of the building's occupancy load.
2. Only one door will be designated for entrance and exit to control the influx and outflow of people.
3. When people enter the building, temperatures will be taken by church staff or designated volunteers. If the temperature is over 100 degrees, she/he will not be allowed to enter the establishment.
4. Adults, youth, and children should not attend church or other church activities if they have a respiratory illness or are feeling/exhibiting any of the following symptoms: sore throat, runny nose, fever, shortness of breath, etc. until corona virus has been ruled out by a medical authority or it has been at least 5 days since their full recovery and mandatory quarantine of 14 days. Family members should not attend either, whether ill or not, as they may be incubating and shedding the virus, which could spread to others. Family members should not return to church until at least 14 days have passed since anyone in their household has been ill.
5. Sixty years old and above or of any age and or have a chronic medical condition like diabetes, high blood pressure, heart disease, obesity, liver and kidney problems, etc., or any underlying problem that makes them either more susceptible to infection (compromised immune system) or which could result in severe medical complications if infected with coronavirus will not attend any church activities and also limit any contact with the general public as per Governor's Executive Order.

Expectations of Behavior

1. Masks /face shields must be worn inside the building at all times.
 - a. Congregational singing is prohibited; however, a soloist with one instrumentalist, or recorded music, is permitted.
 - b. Soloist will wear a face mask at all times when not

singing and encouraged not to face the congregation and use a microphone when singing.

2. Social distancing must be maintained (6 feet). There will be no physical contact among members outside of an individual's household unless medically necessary.
3. Frequent hand washing/hand sanitizing is encouraged.

Restrooms

1. Only one person will be allowed in the bathroom at a time to minimize exposure to others.
2. Wipe down surfaces with disinfectant wipes and any other medical grade disinfectants during and after any activities conducted in the establishment.


Church Building

1. The church door will remain locked Monday thru Friday and only be opened for cleaning and church services on Sundays.
2. Hand sanitizers, alcohol and wipes will be available on the table in front of the church entrance door at all times.
3. All equipment and high-touch surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected throughout the Sunday services and during designated cleaning schedules. When possible, do not clean floors by sweeping or other methods that can disperse pathogens into the air. Vacuums with a HEPA filter will be used wherever possible and if available.
4. All garments and linens will be washed thoroughly after each service or event. During such handling and washing of linens, safety precautions, such as wearing gloves, will be followed.
5. When collecting offering (money donations used for any church-related expenses, such as, but not limited to: rent payment for the building, electricity and water bills, etc.), designated containers like plates and boxes will be placed at the front of the pulpit area, where the pastor delivers her sermons. There will be no passing of the offering basket to avoid contact among members.

Safety protocol for being in the Church Worship Spaces

Be aware that safety will be a primary focus, and will include the kinds of procedures that have been identified by our health care leaders as "good practice" like social distancing, "no

contact” practices, proper hand hygiene, and face mask usage at all times.
