## COVID-19 mitigation plan

Zion Fellowship Guam is committed to following guidance from Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services and Centers for Disease and Control and Prevention for COVID-19 mitigation.

Zion Fellowship meets in a room with an occupancy limit of 50 people, thus, depending on DPHSS guidance limits, occupancy during service is limited as follows:

- If the occupancy limit is 25%, total occupancy for service (pastor and congregation) limited to 12 people in the room.
- If the occupancy limit is 50%, total occupancy for service (pastor and congregation) limited to 25 people in the room.
- If the occupancy limit is 75%, total occupancy for service (pastor and congregation) limited to 37 people in the room.

### Prior to opening

- Signage in place reminding congregants that masks are required and distance of 6 feet or greater to be maintained at all times.
- All tables removed.
- Chairs to be spaced at 6-feet or greater distances. Closer seating allowed only for members of immediate families WHO RESIDE IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD.
- All chairs and common surfaces, including light switches and door handles, to be disinfected before congregants arrive.
- Congregants will be notified that no shared food or beverages will be allowed before or during service.

### Upon arrival

- All people entering the room must do so individually, maintaining at least a 6-foot distance between one another.
- Masks are required for entry.
- Hands will be sanitized upon entry.
- Temperature check will be administered upon entry with a no-contact thermometer. Anyone with a temperature of 99.8 or higher will be denied entry.
- A log will be kept of all people entering. Required information will include:

- Name
- Contact number
- Temperature
- People will be asked if they have been ill in the past two weeks, if a household member has been ill in the past two weeks, or if they have been off-island in the last 30 days.
- No Bibles or other printed material will be distributed.

#### **During service**

- Congregants will be required to maintain a 6-foot distance between one another at all times.
- No re-entry will be allowed for those who leave the service.
- The offering basket will be placed to the side, rather than passed among the congregation, to minimize surface contact.

#### **After service**

- All chairs and common surfaces, including light switches and door handles, to be disinfected
- Attendance log to be maintained by pastor to assist with contact tracing.
