OCTOBER 2020 REOPENING AND REGATHERING FCOG WORSHIP SERVICE FACILITY MITIGATION PLAN

As per Executive Order No. 2020-36, relative to Places of Worship, the First Church of God in Barrigada intends to reopen the church Sanctuary with a set guidelines, precautions, and reopening plan.

All congregants will enter the main door only and exit through the side doors. This should help facilitate traffic and capacity control. There will be a temperature check and short screening questions will be asked before entering the Sanctuary so congregants will be asked to come a little earlier. The church Health and Wellness Team composed of members who are in the medical field will facilitate screening and proper exit of members. Following the EO, we will only allow 25% capacity (50 people) inside the Sanctuary. Speakers will be set up outside for those who would like to stay in the Fellowship Area, still observing social distancing.

The church is adopting the CDC and DPHSS guidelines, is guided by medical expert counsels, and respectful to government officials. The congregants will be asked to adhere to the following measures:

- If you have any flu-like symptoms or you are sick or you don't feel comfortable coming yet, we kindly ask you to worship from home. Watch our Online Worship Service via Youtube.
- We recommend that the elderly, or those with other existing illnesses that put you at greater risk to please continue to join us online, instead of in person.
- Please wear mask at all times.
- Please observe social distancing inside and outside the Sanctuary, staying six (6) feet away from other people. Every other pew will be closed. The seating will be staggered by families and individuals. Please sit only with your household group per pew or two individuals per pew.
- There will be no Kid's Church at this time.
- Offering box will be available in the church where people can drop offerings instead of passing the offering bag. You can make offering as you enter or as you leave.
- Hand sanitizers are available throughout the church. Extra masks will also be available.
- There will be No Snack Fellowship after service at this time. We encourage you to bring your own bottled water.
- Congregants will be dismissed row by row, beginning with the back rows.
- Appropriate signages are posted strategically including 6 ft. social distancing marks at the floors.
- Church facilities, materials, and instruments will be sanitized before and after usage.
