Parishioner / Volunteer	Face mask in use while conducting any person to person contact.Wash hands periodically.
Observation Fever Coughing Shortness/labored breathing 	 NO ENTRY into main facility when displaying any symptoms Anyone displaying above symptoms while on premises will be asked leave and may return at a respectful time with approved clearance.

Temperature Screening	 Use of no contact thermometer Readings 100.2 and below – allowed entry Readings 100.3 or higher – not allowed entry
Sanitization / Disinfect	 Sanitize and clean building before and after services
Offering	Collection box available, and via PayPal (on website)
In-Person Service	 Up to 50% occupancy during service Practice social distancing Avoid physical contact (hand shaking, hugs etc.) Usher is available at the entrance Hand sanitizer available in designated areas
Livestreaming	Available on Facebook and the website
Signage and Markings	 Post readily available signage at the entrance, restrooms, and throughout the facility
Communion	Congregants should provide personal elements
