

BUSINESS MITIGATION PLAN

Pursuant to the Government's guidance through Department of Public Health and Social Services' Memo guidance 2021-13, effective at 8am, April 16, 2021, Fusion Dance Center (FDC) has implemented the following protocols to comply with mitigation measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19:

Capacity

The studio will allow the number of students and teachers per studio as follows:

- Studio 1 maximum of 30 students, 1 teacher per class session
- Studio 2 maximum of 20 students, 1 teach per class session

The main lobby will have the following capacity:

- Front desk maximum of 2 people
- Indoor observation/seating area maximum of 10 people

Students will be required to social distance during class. The main lobby will be accessible for customers on a limited basis with social distancing measures in place including reducing the number of seats and separating each 6 feet apart. Social distancing markers will be placed on the floor. Any excess capacity will be queued outside the entrance.

<u>Entry</u>

Patrons are subject to temperature check using a temperature scanning device at the entrance. A hand sanitization station is available at the entrance. Face mask is required for entry. Students and instructors are required to wear face masks upon entry, but may remove them once inside the studio during class. Students waiting in the lobby before, in between, and after classes are required to wear face masks.

Screening

Teachers are subject to temperature check and Covid symptom screening upon reporting to work. Teachers and patrons are requested to stay home if they are exhibiting any flu-like symptoms such as fever, cold, cough, etc.

Restrooms

The studio's locker areas are off-limits. The restroom with shower is not available for use.

Transportation

Parents are encouraged to drop off and pick up their child(ren) only. They are allowed to view students from designated viewing windows while observing and maintaining social distance measures. Parents are also encouraged to wait in their vehicles during classes and not hang out in the lobby or hallway.

Sanitization

The premises will be cleaned with disinfectants, with focus on floors, counter tops, door handles, seats and restrooms. Landlord is also cleaning the common areas on a daily basis. PPEs such as masks are available for teachers. Disinfectants are available at the front desk and studios for teachers' use.

Work Shifts

Teachers only come to the studio when they are scheduled to teach. At the most, there are 2 instructors teaching at the same time, but are in 2 separate studio rooms. There are no crowded communal spaces shared by teachers.

Training, Education & Awareness

Signage and posters for preventative and safety tips are posted in the lobby and entrance doors. This will help keep our patrons informed about how to help prevent the spread of the virus.

Teachers are briefed regarding use of proper PPE, enhanced disinfection measures in accordance with CDC guidelines.
