2.	Housekeeping	• Classrooms are sanitized and disinfected before and after class and when needed.
	Requirements	• Frequently touched surfaces and used objects are cleaned and disinfected daily.
		• Floors are swept and mopped daily.
		• Sleeping mats/cots are exclusively assigned and labeled for individual use.
3.	Handwashing Units	• Sanitizing solutions are available in each classroom and at every entrance.
		• 4 handwashing units are available in Infant Room.

	 Toddler Room has access to the staff bathroom and children wash their hands in the children bathroom stations next to classroom. K3, K4, & K5 students have access to hand washing units in children's bathroom.
4. Restrooms	 There are two children's bathrooms available. One for boys and one for girls. Only two children are permitted in each at a time. Bathrooms are disinfected after use and they are swept and mopped daily.

III. COVID-Related Protocols

1. Masks/Face Shields	 Employees and children in the K3, Pre-Kindergarten, & Kindergarten classes must wear masks at all times. Employees must wear a Mask & Face Shield at all times.
2. Attention to High-Risk students and/or employees	• <i>High risk individuals (grandparents, people with underlying conditions) are encouraged to not drop and pick up children.</i>
3. Students, faculty, staff with COVID-19 symptoms	 Must stay home and quarantine for 14 days If person in quarantine or in isolation becomes sick, they should seek medical care and stay home until after: ✓ At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND ✓ At least 24 hours with no fever without use of anti-fever medication AND ✓ Symptoms significantly improving If the person tested positive for COVID-19 but has no symptoms (asymptomatic), they should stay home until: ✓ After 10 days passed since a positive COVID-19 test. IV. Hygiene and Daily Practices

1.	Orientation of Students, Faculty, Staff	 Parent Orientation before school opened Ongoing reminders in Google classrooms for each class & age group Monthly Newsletters with updates sent out Staff meeting held monthly with updates on any new procedures Safety Guidelines provided to parents and staff Students are taught the importance of hand washing, social distancing, and the use of masks
2.	Detail Cleaning and Disinfection	 Toys used in classrooms are sanitized and washed after every use. Disposable gloves are used when changing children and they are changed after each use. Floors in each classroom/dining areas/ office are swept, mopped, and vacuumed daily. Frequently touched surfaces and used objects are cleaned and disinfected daily. Cribs/playpens are cleaned and wiped down daily.

3. Availability and Access to PPEs	• Masks and gloves are readily available.
4. Face Covering	 Children in K3, Pre-Kindergarten, & Kindergarten must wear masks at all times on school premises. Staff must wear a mask & face shield at all times. No Mask No Entry
5. Hand Hygiene	 Staff must wash/sanitize hands: ✓ before and after changing diapers. ✓ before and after handling food. ✓ before and after disinfecting/sanitizing Sinks located in (2) Staff bathrooms (4) Children's bathrooms (2) Kitchens Hand sanitizers are located at every classroom/office entrance and in every room.
6. Drop-off Procedures	 School time of operation is 8am – 5pm Faculty/students/staff must pass through screening area before entering the school building Persons/Children with a high temperature of 99 F or above or other signs of illness will not be admitted into the building. Each age group (Infant, Toddlers, K3 Group 1, K3 Group 2, Prekindergarten, & Kindergarten) has their own assigned doors for drop off/pickup.
7. Cohort Activities	 Each child will be assigned their own supplies (crayons, pencils, and papers), sleeping mats/cots, and their own assigned desk/chairs, and play area. Bags/blankets will be sent home everyday. All toys, sleeping mats/cots, and frequently touched objects are sanitized after use. We will be minimizing congregation of students who are not in the same cohort. Every class will have their morning prayers, exercises, and activities in their own designated classrooms.
8. Student Access to Drinking Water	• Students are to bring their own water bottles/drinks. Water fountains are temporarily unavailable.

9. Classroom arrangements	 Children/desks are distanced at least 4ft. apart Toddler & K3 Group 2 classrooms have Plexiglas to help minimize contact. Desks, areas for play time, playpens, mats & cots, will be individually marked for each child and will be spaced out for social distancing.
10. Restriction of non- essential campus visitors, volunteers, activities	 Parents/Visitors/Non essential personnel are not permitted in the classrooms. Parents/Visitors may enter office only to pay tuition or turn in needed documents. Persons/Children who have a high temperature of 99 F or above or other signs of illness will not be admitted into the building. All school activities tentative Any school activities where physical distancing of at least 1 meter cannot be implemented in full will be suspended
11. Restrictions on offices, lounges, communal spaces	 Only 2 people at a time will be permitted in office Only 4 people at a time will be permitted in staff lounge.
12. Daily Activities: Arrival and Dismissal	 Parents should maintain a minimum distance of 6ft from person to person at all times when dropping and picking up children. Each age group will have their assigned entrance/exit for arrivals/departures. Children's temperature will be taken at their assigned doors by their assigned teachers upon arrival at school and will head directly to their classroom after temperature is taken.
13. Daily Activities: Recess, Breaks, Lunch	 Each classroom will have their daily activities/lessons in their own classes. Toddlers and K3 classes will be the only classes utilizing the dining room. K4 & K5 meals will be served in their own individual classrooms. Lunchtime is staggered to help limit the number of children in the dining room.
