



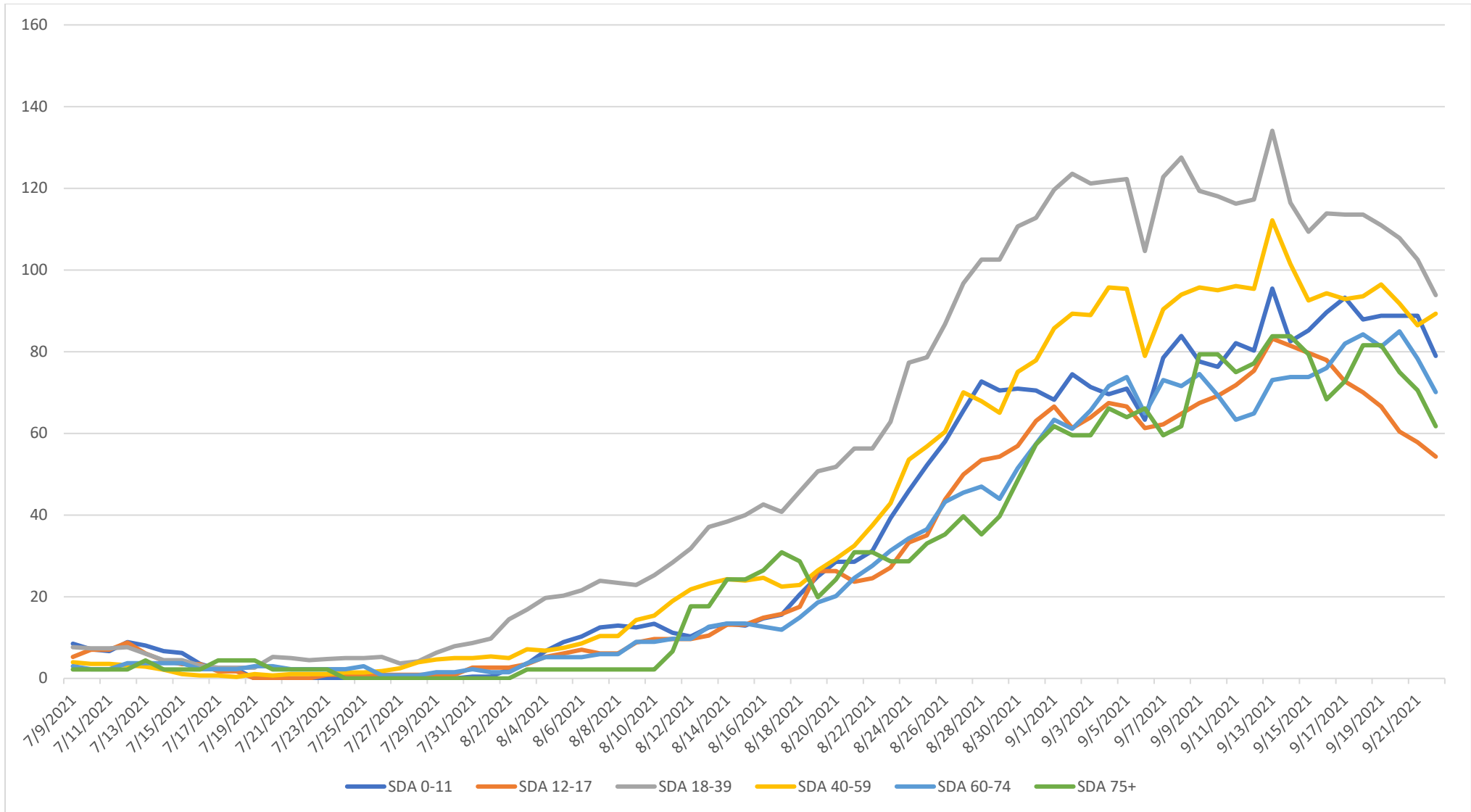

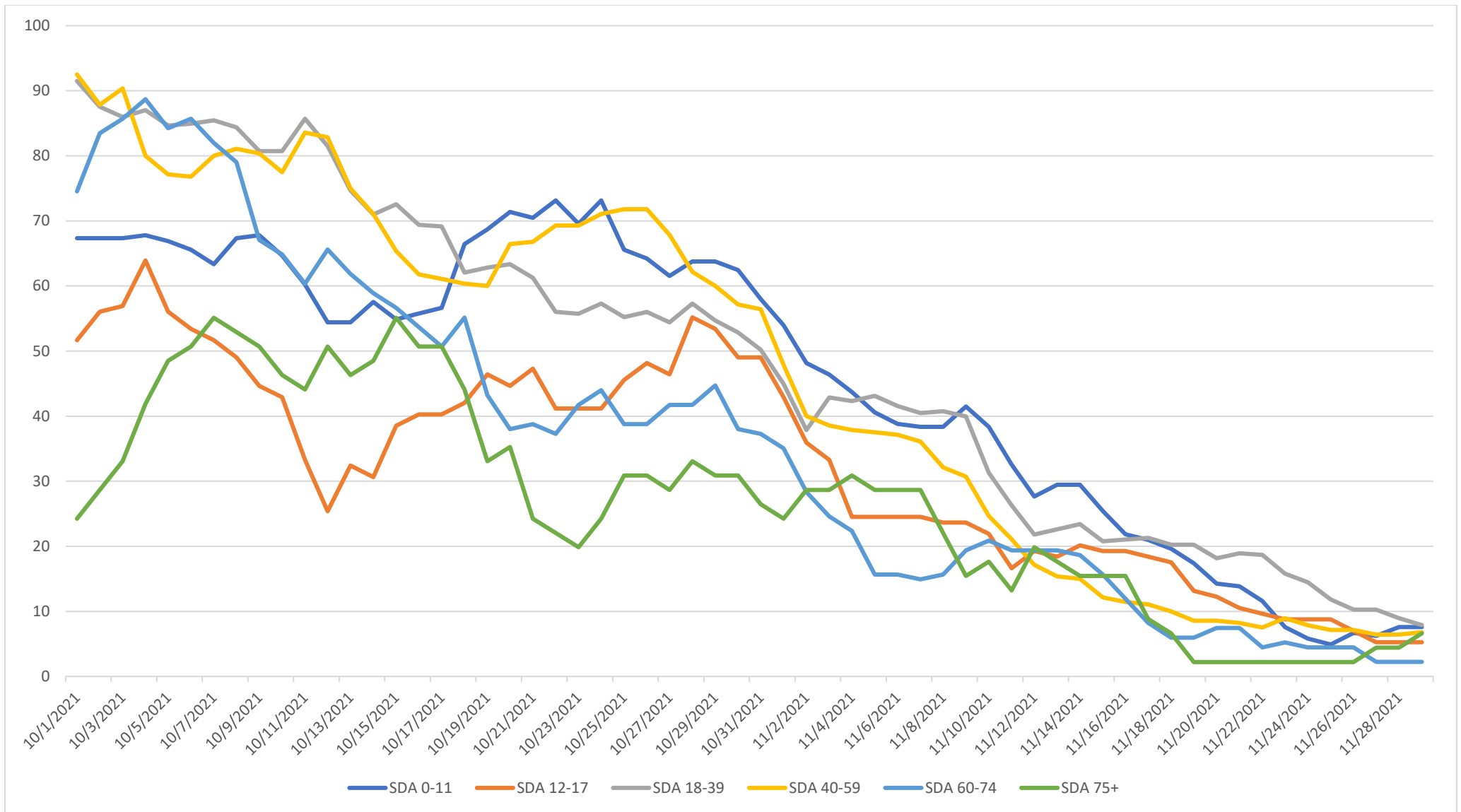

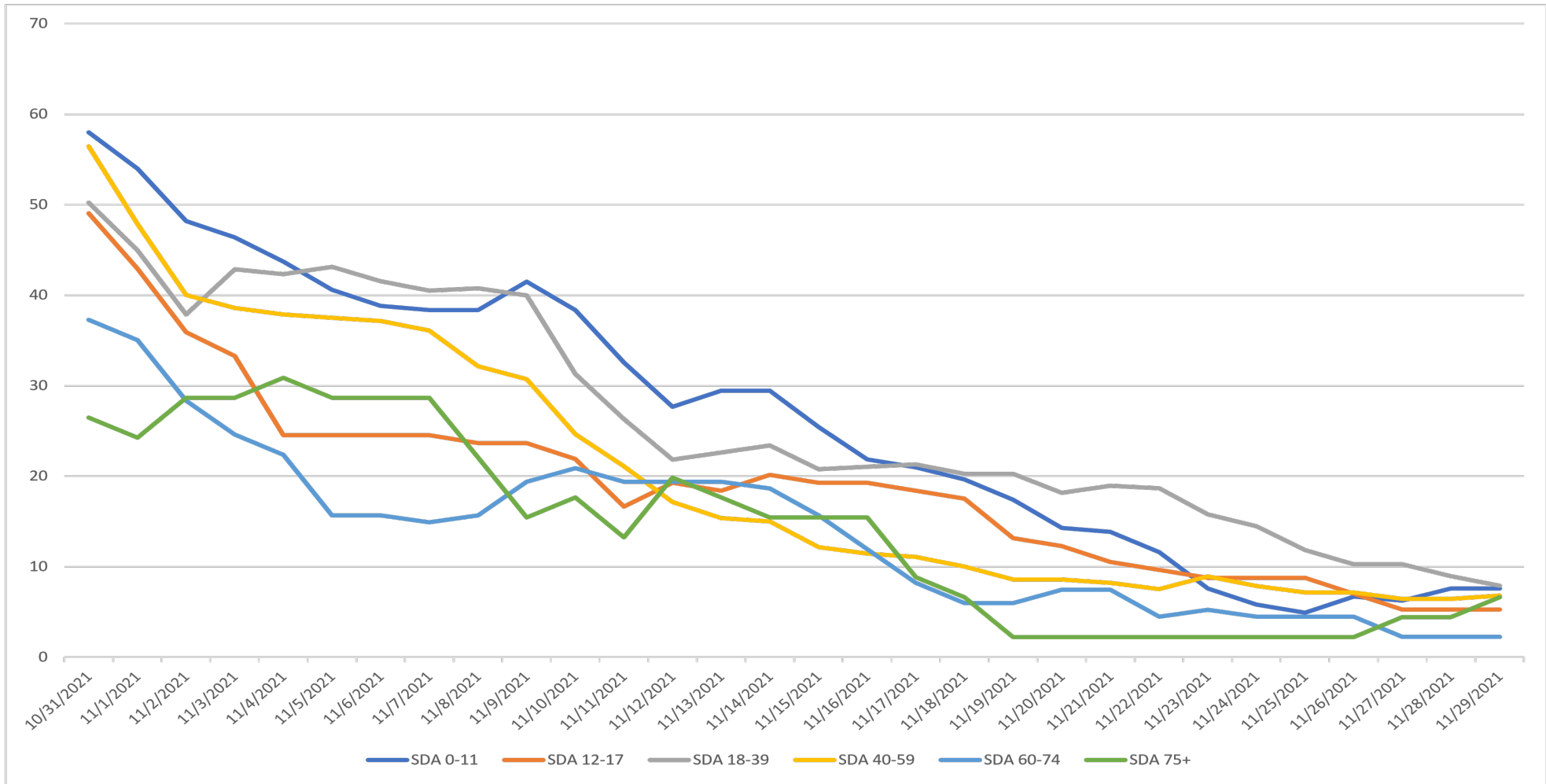
7/9/2021 to 9/21/2021 by age groups:

As can be noted from the surge in August and September 2021, it was the 18-39 age group that had the highest SDA of cases.



10/1/2021 to 11/28/2021 by age groups:

While the surge continues in October, all age groups start to show decreases in November.

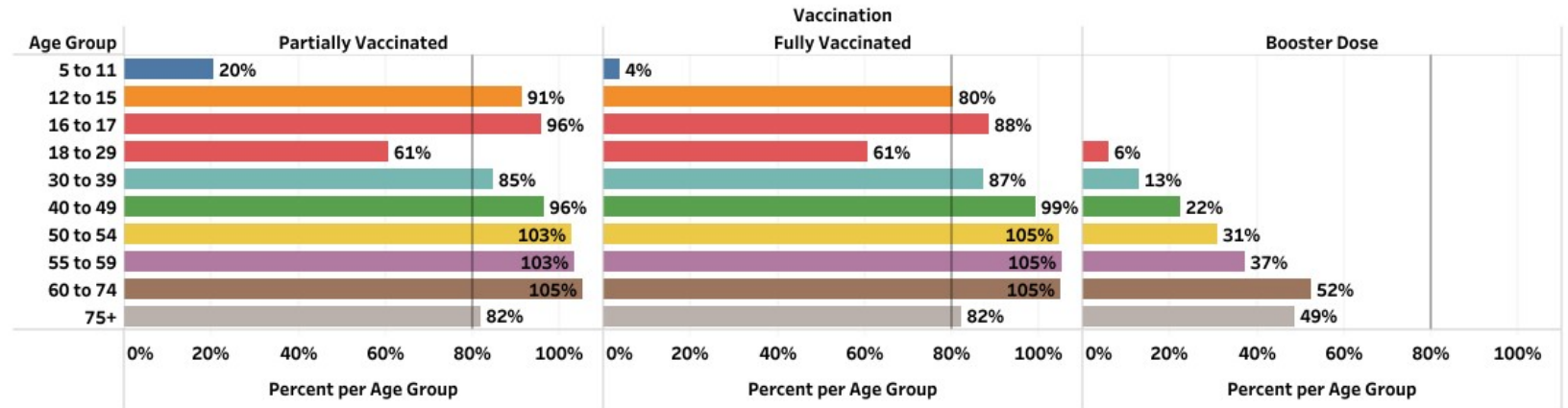
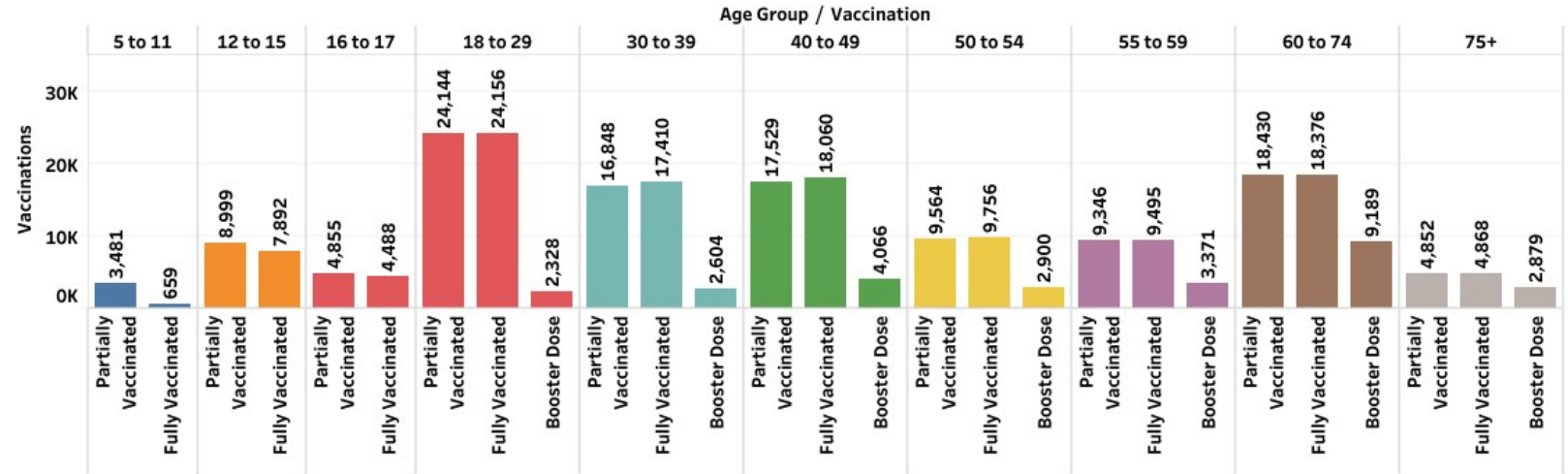


10/31/2021 to 11/29/2021 by age groups:

All age groups are showing decreases and convergence in November, and it can be noted the 18-39 age group still remains higher than other age groups in the past several weeks.

***Disclaimer:**

Age group population are based on estimates. This will be reconciled when 2020 census data per age group is released.

Partially Vaccinated is comprised of individuals that have received their first dose of Pfizer or first dose of Moderna.

Fully Vaccinated is comprised of individuals that have received their second dose of Pfizer, second dose of Moderna, or a single dose of Janssen.

Booster Dose is comprised of individuals that have received a following dose of Pfizer, Moderna, or Janssen after being fully vaccinated.
