


Past 28 days: The SDRA of cases continues to be less than 30 per day.




**The past 28 days: there is a continued decrease in testing,
with the SDRA test positivity rate continues to be under 5%.**



Past 28 days: Continued declining case rates across all age groups, with convergence.



Past 28 days: The island-wide, daily COVID-19 hospitalized and ICU count continues to decline. Deaths are sporadic.



Past 28 days: Most cases are asymptomatic.
