



The SDRA of cases for the past 4 weeks, continues to consistently be over 100 cases per day.




Note travelers tests in blue with "local tests" in grey.

The local positivity rate continues to be higher than the overall positivity rate (above 10%).






The island-wide, daily COVID-19 hospitalized count has increased in mid-July and has fluctuated above the surge indicator of 20 per day, and while the ICU has recently increased, it is not above the surge threshold of 5 per day. Deaths continue to be sporadic.



By age, there has been a recent uptick in the over 60-74+ age group, however, in the past week all adult age groups are converging and show a recent decrease.



Most cases continue to be asymptomatic.
